Men's Retreat provides a relaxing fellowship experience

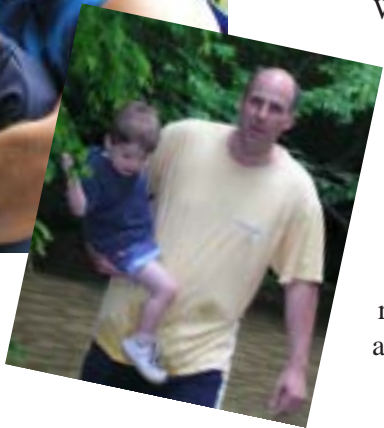
Who would have guessed? Some 35+ Northside men, young and less young, journeyed from Indianapolis to Hardin, Kentucky.
